ATTENDANCE AREAS

Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) - Fort Sam Houston and Camp Bullis comprise the geographic boundaries of FSHISD. Children of military personnel residing on these Installations are eligible to attend Pre-Kindergarten through grade 12. Parents who do not live on the Installations may be eligible to apply through the Non-Resident Transfer (NRT) program; see www.fshisd.net or call 210-368-8707 for information. Fort Sam Houston Elementary School, 4351 Nursery Road, serves grades PK-5. Robert G. Cole Middle and High School, 4001 Winans Road, serves grades 6-12.

Children must be four years old on or before September 1, 2022 and meet State eligibility requirements to enroll in Pre- Kindergarten, five years old on or before September 1, 2022 to enroll in kindergarten and six years old on or before September 1, 2022 to enroll in first grade.

ONLINE REGISTRATION / DOCUMENTS NEEDED

Parents of students who attended FSHISD schools in 2021-2022 need to complete an online registration process. See www.fshisd.net for the link. Parents must complete this process before their students will be assigned a teacher, class or course schedule.

Parents of students new to FSHISD schoolswill create an account and complete registration forms online using the link at www.fshisd.net. Parents must complete all online forms before going to the school with the following documents to complete registration.

- Proof of residency (within District boundaries this is a current Minol Utility Bill or newly issued Lease)

- 4. Social Security card
- 5. Last report card/withdrawal from previous school (if applicable)
- 6. Any legal documentation pertaining to your student (if applicable)
- 7. Enrolling parent's driver's license
